- 1) Club Registration Form – Player, coaches, and officials (in-house)
Can be found in the Club Admin Page on the website. Clubs to fill this in once and submit to the YBL. Players will need their LP licence number. Workforce including Coaches that are club based will need their number added.

- 2) Individual registration (post Club registration Form)
Any further registrations after the submission of the Club Registration Form will be required via the online form found in the Club Admin Page.

- 3) Level 1 Coaches, Basketball England Changes to licences
- 4) Level 2 Coaches
*DBS Requirements /Safeguarding Certificates for Level 2+ Coaches/Bench Personnel
Licence Requirements*
- 5) Who can officiate and who can sit on the bench?
**Level 1 coaches are now redundant. If they are to support their coach, they can sit on the bench as registered 'Bench Personnel'. However, they do not have powers of a coach. Any Assistant Coach will now have to be level 2 or above. Level 1 coaches must be supervised by a level 2 in a training session. However, we are for clarification from BE regarding insurance purposes.
Anyone sitting on the bench will also need to be licenced. The A number is not a licence.
For example, if you have a stats person, they either need to be registered as statistician or bench personnel.
Level 2 coaches will be required to have their DBS and Safeguarding in place to receive their C or LC licence. Workforce do not get charged in the YBL.**

- 6) Safeguarding Offer from the YBL to member clubs

- 7) Fixture Rearrangement, Forfeit of Fixture, Tip/Venue Changes in-season

- 8) Courses (Lv1 & Lv2 Referee and Table)
- 9) Courses (Lv1 & Lv2 Coach)

The YBL is continuing its mission to help the workforce, with Lv1 and Lv2 referee and table courses. Please contact the YBL if your club is interest in starting this journey or is ready for the next step.

The Coaching courses are now in the planning stages and will be rolled out shortly.

10) Scoresheet submission / Standards / Official YBL scoresheet

Remember to submit the scoresheet and the game results on the day of the fixture taking place.

The YBL Scoresheets are available on the Table Development section of the website. The YBL Scoresheet to use is generally the Traditional one. However, this format is no longer taught in the Level1 or Level 2 courses, so the running scoresheet is also permitted. The traditional sheet is now being phased out.

11) Finance (invoices and deadline)

Invoices for teams and clubs are now being looked at and any updates will be in the Club's Secure Page.

12) Don't break the official (Discipline)

We want to keep our new workforce. We'll be asking referees to set the standard at the beginning of the game of what is expected of coaches, players etc. The abuse that these referees sometimes get stops them returning and we then lose them from the workforce. We must change this pattern.
