Rearrangement before the Rearrangement Deadline

Agreed by both teams prior to the rearrangement deadline. HOME TEAM must complete the Game Form.

Rearrangement and scoresheets in-season (non-appointed leagues)

a) After the rearrangement deadline all fixtures should to be played as per fixtures on website.

- b) In season rearrangements can be done with the agreement of both clubs. <u>HOME TEAM</u> must complete the <u>Game Form</u>.
- c) THERE IS NO FEE FOR REARRANGMENTS WHERE THE YBL DO NOT APPOINT OFFICIALS.
- d) If a scoresheet for a fixture is not received the website will not be updated.
 - 1. It is the HOME CLUB'S responsibility to ensure the fixture changes are displayed corrected on the YBL website.
 - 2. It is the HOME CLUB'S responsibility to send the YBL a copy of the scoresheet.
 - 3. If a game has not been resulted (YBL have not received a scoresheet) by the end of the regular season as set out above, the fixture will be automatically voided. (Please see section regarding appeals).
 - 4. The HOME CLUB/TEAM should confirm with the visiting team they are attending at least 7 days before fixture.
 - 5. Failure to attend without informing the HOME CLUB/TEAM will result in the fixture being awarded to the HOME TEAM.
 - A team may forfeit the fixture outside of seven days. (Forfeit 1 See Fixture Fees Table)
 A team may forfeit the fixture within seven days. (Forfeit 2 See Fixture Fees Table)

Rearrangement and scoresheets in-season (appointed leagues)

a) After the rearrangement deadline all fixtures should to be played as per fixtures on the website.

b) Both teams need to agree a rearrangement and a new fixture date agreed. If the <u>Game Form</u> is submitted ten days before the scheduled date there is no charge. Clubs will need to arrange officials for the new fixture date if the appointed officials are then no longer available.

c) Failure to inform the league will result in the clubs being responsible for the officials' costs.

d) A £20 fee is due for games rearranged within nine days of the fixture with the <u>Game Form</u> submitted by the rearranging team. The fee is to be paid by the club requesting the rearrangement. Payment of the fee is due when the <u>Game Form</u> is submitted. A rearrangement will not be changed on the website until the fee is paid.

e) A rearrangement is a movement of the date.

f) Use the Game Code as the reference on the <u>Game Form</u>

g) The Home Team will supply two new dates, if both clubs cannot agree a new fixture date, the league MUST be informed and will in the first instance provide a new fixture date.

h) If a team has agreed to attend the fixture, which should be done via email by the home team at least 7 days before the scheduled date, and the team is a no-show or inform you that they are unable to attend, and a rearrangement is not suitable then following two options are available.

dl) The team may forfeit the fixture outside of seven days. (Forfeit 1 – See Fixture Fees Table) d2) The team may forfeit the fixture within seven days. (Forfeit 2 – See Fixture Fees Table)

If a fixture is not played, for whatever reason, and the league has not been informed, both teams are then required to submit a report to the league at <u>info@ybl.org.uk</u> explaining why, and the league will then take the appropriate action. This could be a default win and a £50.00 fine and payment of any officials' expenses.

If a team is rearranging a fixture, where officials are appointed by the league, the club will be responsible for finding two independent referees if the appointed officials are unable to officiate.

Keep email/messages as evidence for proof if asked for.



Fixture Fees



League Standings

Game Points for all competitions or divisions.

3 points for a win (W) 1 point for a loss [participation] (L) head-to-head.

Forfeit Points for all competitions or divisions.

0 points for a default/forfeited or voided (V) game – this affects your Void Points for all competitions or divisions.

20 baskets for a win (F) 0 baskets for a loss (A)

-1 point for a void (pts)

Table standings will be determined on the game points (pts).

In the league standings for any division at U14 or below it will only show the Game Points (pts), win/loss and games played. During the season if teams are on the same points, they will be ranked using baskets scored (F) and then on points difference if the same. At the conclusion of the season if teams are on the same points the league standings will be decided by the head-to-head of those teams. If the head-to-head is identical the points will be determined by points difference across those teams.

Team withdrawal

On or before 30 January, all fixtures (and points, if any) shall be deleted from the league. On or after 31 January fixtures will be awarded to the opposition with a 20-0 win (forfeit).

Play-Down Rule

The YBL will consider requests from clubs on a case-by-case request. Please contact a YBL member of staff for more information.

Linking to the YBL

The YBL is a league within the BE portal. All clubs must affiliate to the YBL league on their portal. Within your portal place all team members (including coaches and bench personnel) into the team to enable licence eligibility checks.

Clubs that have not linked to the YBL will incur an administration charge for any checks that we need to complete regarding eligibility.

Licence Check £10.00 PER-PERSON Charge for checking with Basketball England. Any player, member or official not linked to the YBL

Registrations & Licences

All members (team mangers etc), players and coaches must be registered with Basketball England (BE) with the correct licence.

You can register as many players for a team as you wish.

Players must have a 'P' player licence issued by Basketball England and be assigned into a team on their club portal for the YBL to check eligibility.

Coaches must have a 'C' coach licence issued by Basketball England and be assigned into a team on their club portal for the YBL to check eligibility.

All Team Managers/Game Day Delegates/or Bench Personnel must have the appropriate licence issued by Basketball England and be assigned into a team on their club portal for the YBL to check eligibility.

The YBL does not require any player forms or registrations to be sent to the league, all players, coach, bench (team managers/game day delegates) and staff registrations can be checked on the BE portal.

The exception to this is, the YBL will require a copy of a player licence if they are. 1. A player playing in another local league, other than the YBL, (senior only). 2. A player is registered national league (where applicable).

Licence Fines £20.00 PER-PLAYER Not registered with the YBL/BE Profile linked to YBL

Player transfers

a) Club to Club - agreement of both clubs and agreement of player/parent/guardian.

b) Update the Basketball England portal.

c) Complete the YBL <u>Transfer Online Form</u>

d) Provide evidence of agreement, (e.g., email trail) to info@ybl.org.uk

e) We will issue confirmation and move the player to the new club and once received the player may play for their new team.



In-Game Coaching

All YBL games are required to have a minimum Level 2 Coach who is qualified and licenced at all age group games (U17 and below), or any senior games who have players or members who are 17 or below. If a game has not got a qualified and licenced coach to start the game, the game should not take place. If a coach being disqualified from an age-group game, where no suitable Level 2 qualified and registered assistant coach is present and listed on the scoresheet, the game will be stopped, and the opposing team awarded the game 20-00. This will then be referred to the YBL Board of Directors for review.

All Age-Group teams are expected to travel with at least two appropriate adults in line with the Basketball England Safeguarding Policy.

Not having a qualified and licenced level 2 coach present per-team, invalidates everyone's insurance. If you need further information or clarification, please see the information on Basketball England's website.

Game Abandoned

If for whatever reason the game must be stopped and/or abandoned, then complete the scoresheet as shown in the latest YBL Help Sheet for Table Officials. <u>Table Official Help Sheet (v6.0)</u>.

Officials

Linking to the YBL

All officials MUST link to the YBL or be listed on the program that the YBL uses for appointments.

This is free of charge and can be done at the point of registering for your licence.

Failure to link your profile to the YBL will result in sanctions to both the club and official (where clubs are appointing their own officials).

Official's Criteria

All officials must wear appropriate uniform to officiate within the YBL. YBL top or a Basketball England top with black trousers and black trainers/shoes.

Requirement for referees All officials to be correctly qualified with Basketball England and have the appropriate licence.

At any level of YBL Games

SECOND OFFICIAL Level 1 or above SECOND OFFICIAL (SENIOR GAMES) Level 2 or Above Unless appointed by the YBL.

Payment of officials

Level 2 OR ABOVE

It is the responsibility of the home club to pay all officials. A payment guide can be found within the YBL Official's Section on the website.

Appointment of Official's

The YBL will appoint referees to the following divisions or competitions, U21 Men & U21 Women, Development Women division, Development Men division, NorthantsPrem division, The Challenge Cup U17 (if at central venue, organised by the league), The Challenge Cup Men & The Beth Matthews Cup

Officials MUST find their own replacement if they are unable to do a fixture after they have confirmed.

Neutrality

Basketball England rules state that the crew chief must be a neutral L2+ official. The YBL acknowledge that this may not always be possible. If an in-house crew chief is appointed, it must be with the prior agreement of the opposition. BE rules state recommend the minimum requirement for each fixture is two referees and table officials.

In-Game Sanctions

Zone & Full Court Press for all divisions except cup competitions.

For Zone Defense being played illegally (in Quarter 2, 4 and Overtime) after a verbal warning. If a full court press is played when the team has a 20-point advantage after a warning.

The crew chief can call an 'Official's Time-Out' with the coaches and their co-official will be called to the centre circle and given a verbal warning that they must cease playing zone defense or playing a full court press (whichever applies) and remind them of the potential sanctions.

The coaches will be given a further 30 seconds to reinforce this message with their players.

Once play has resumed following this 'Official's Time-Out' any further infringements of the rule will result in the coach receiving a 'W' technical foul in the first instance.

This will be recorded as a 'W' (not a 'C') on the scoresheet (YBL Scoresheets have a box for the 'W'). The opposition will be awarded one freethrow.

Any further infringements of these rules will result in the coach receiving a technical foul (this time recorded as 'C'). The opposition will be awarded one free-throw.

A coach will not be ejected until they have received two recorded C's on a scoresheet. A 'W' recorded technical will not be counted as a ('C'), but the opposing team will still receive the same one free-throw penalty.

If a coach has been ejected due to repeated breaches of these rules the crew chief must inform the league.

Discipline

When a coach, team follower, spectator, official or player comes to a game, they come with the intent of participating in the game in good spirit.

Participants will receive an automatic sanction when their points reach (or exceeds) the following thresholds, 15, 30, 40 & 45. The sanction or suspension will be for the next scheduled game for that individual.

Points will be reset for each season unless otherwise directed by the Board of Directors in accordance with Basketball England's Disciplinary Code or the Game Regulations for the current season.

If an incident occurs that is not covered below, the BE Code of Conduct can be used.

Financial sanctions will be for players aged 18 and over. Repeat infractions (juniors players exceeding 15 points) will result in clubs being issued financial sanctions on behalf of junior players (at the discretion of the Board of Directors).

Clubs will receive email notification of any in-game sanctions issued. These sanctions will be recorded and visible in your clubs Secure Page.

Basketball England's Disciplinary Panel/Safeguarding Panel will be informed of all incidents that meet their threshold for referral.






Under 9 Central Venue League






Under 11 Central Venue League
