<p><b>Half-Court Defence</b></p>	<p>Yes</p> 	<p>When a team reaches a 20-point lead must play half-court defence. Teams can attempt to rebound, however once the opposition has secured clear possession/control of the ball (including dribbling in their own back court), the other team MUST return into their own half (around the throw-in lines) and may play defence once the ball is in their defensive back court.</p>
